WHO CAN BE TESTED?

- Individuals who live in a community impacted by COVID-19.
- Individuals who have a known exposure to a person with confirmed COVID-19 or symptoms of COVID-19 and at least 5 days have passed since exposure.
- Individuals who work in a job that puts them at high risk for exposure (jail, homeless shelter, nursing home, assisted living facility, migrant worker, food processing facility, or a business that limits the ability to social distance, or has repeated close contact with the public).

WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO:

- Registration is encouraged. Please register before arriving to testing site.
- Please bring your insurance card if you have one. No other form of identification is needed.
- Please wear a mask when you arrive at the testing location.
- The test is a nasopharyngeal swab. It can cause mild discomfort but is a quick procedure.
- You will receive a call with your results within 48-72 hours. If positive, you will receive an additional call from the Kent County Health Department who will conduct a brief interview with you.
