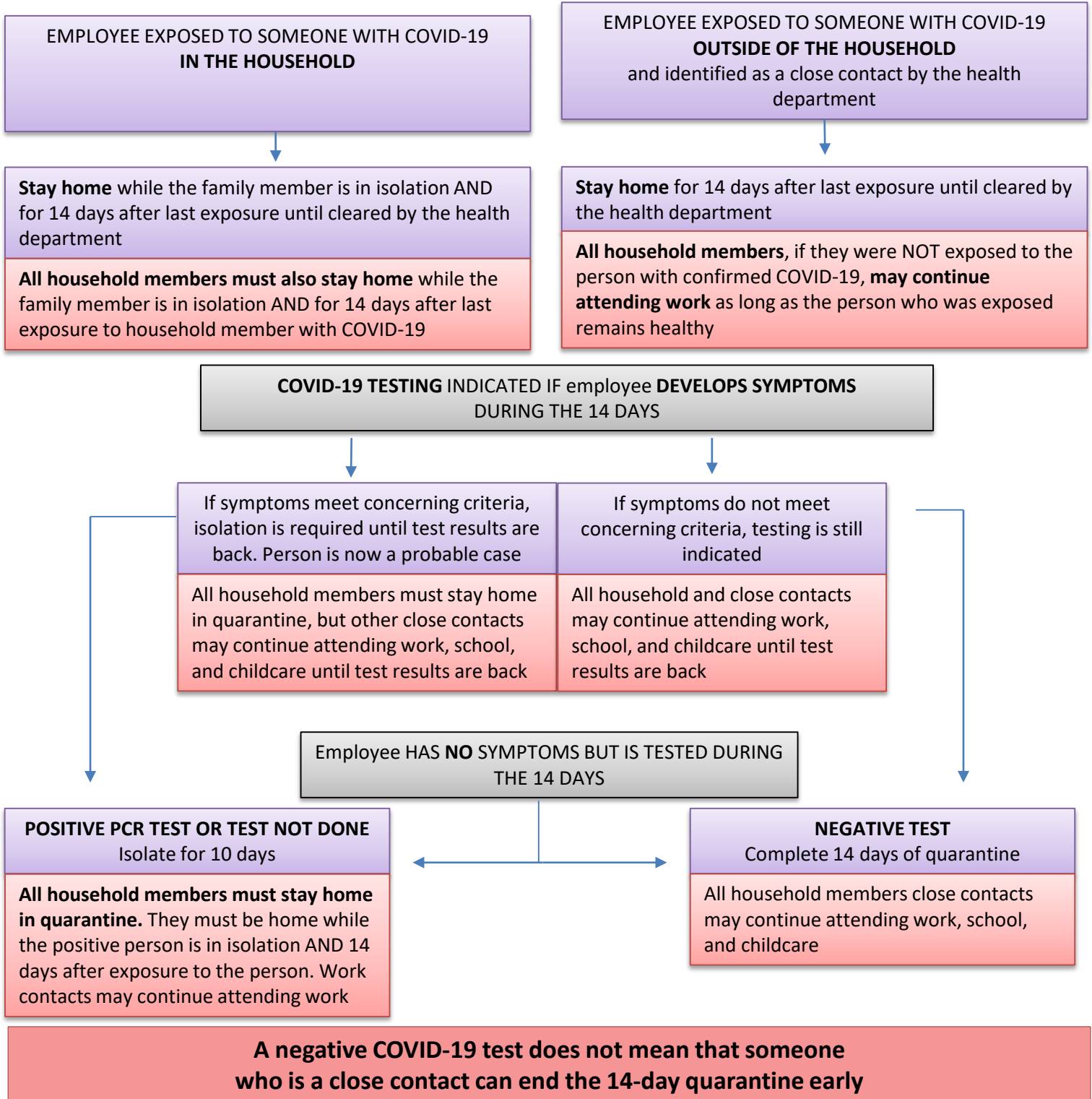




# Employees who have known exposure to person with confirmed COVID-19

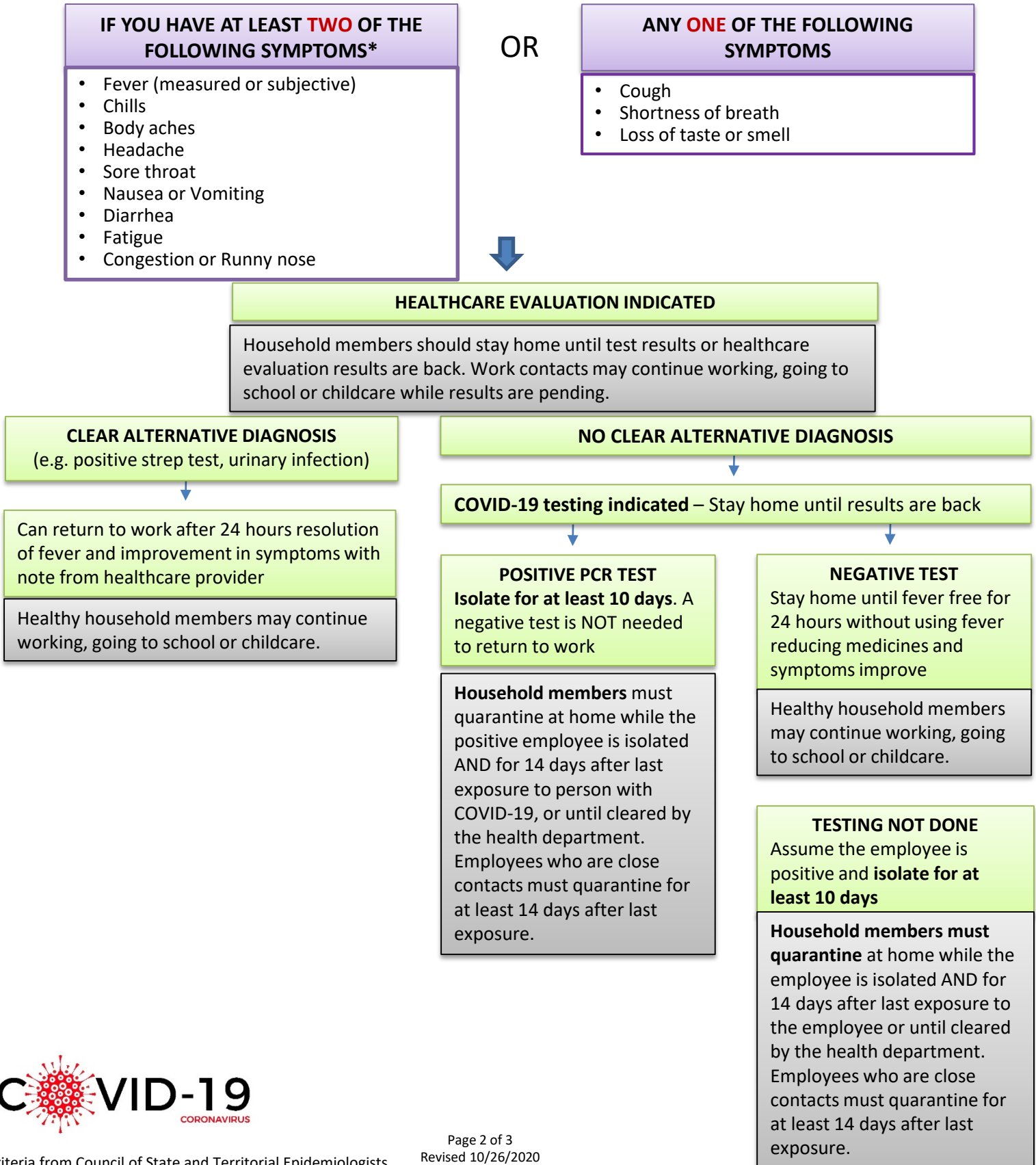
- **Stay home for 14 days** after last exposure until cleared by the health department
- Consider COVID-19 testing
- Must complete 14 days of quarantine **EVEN** if test is negative





# Employee has symptoms concerning for COVID-19

Employee screens positive for a **symptom** on screener AND has **no known exposure** to someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days:



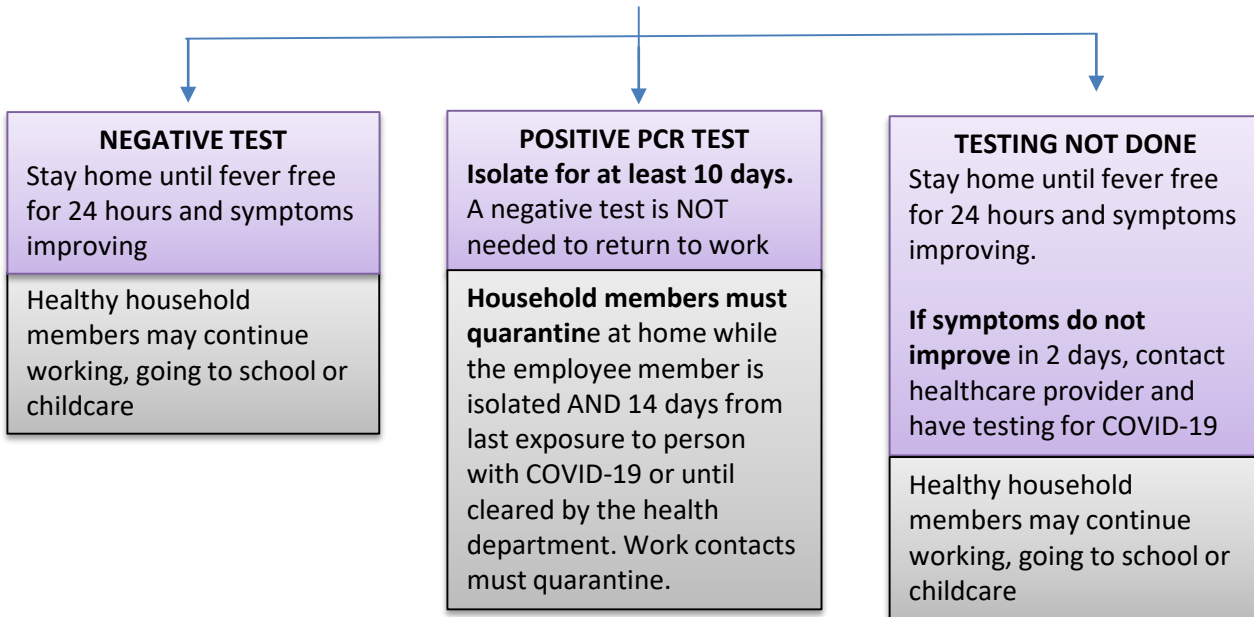
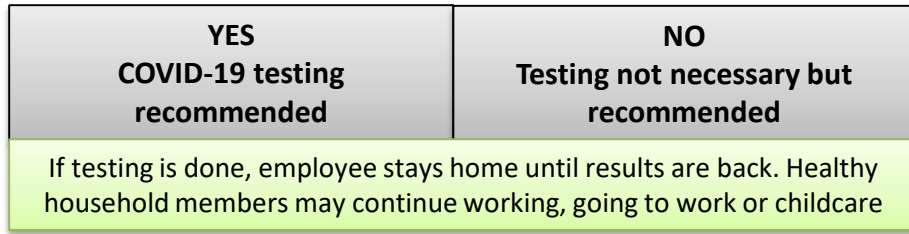

# Employee has symptoms but does not meet criteria on page 2

Your symptoms DO NOT meet the criteria below.

Have you been around anyone who has been sick in the past 14 days?



**SYMPTOMS CONCERNING FOR COVID-19:**

Any **TWO** of the following:

- Fever (measured or subjective)
- Chills
- Body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Congestion or Runny nose

If you **do not** meet these criteria, then follow the guidance above

**OR**

**ONE** of the following:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Loss of taste or smell

If a person tests positive for COVID-19 with a PCR test and does NOT have symptoms:

- A repeat test is not needed for the next 3 months
- Quarantine is not needed if the person is exposed to someone
- If the person develops symptoms concerning for COVID, the decision to test for COVID-19 should be made with a physician on a case by case basis
