Two viruses, seasonal influenza and COVID-19 are circulating throughout the community at the same time. Since little is known about the risk of having both viruses, it is extremely important for you and your family to get your flu shot. Getting a flu vaccine is more important than ever during 2020-2021 to protect yourself, your family and your community from flu. A flu vaccine this season can also help reduce the burden on our healthcare systems responding to the COVID-19 pandemic and caring for COVID-19 patients.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends everyone six months and older get a flu shot. The Kent County Health Department is offering flu shots at the following locations.
