

“A SHOT OF LOVE” CAMPAIGN – VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR DUTIES

Mission of “A Shot of Love” campaign is to canvass door to door and share about the importance of the COVID19 vaccination, leave information, and register individuals for vaccination.

- Looking for a volunteer who is inviting and friendly.
- Time commitment – 3.5 hours. 3:30 – 7pm weekdays & 12:30 – 4pm Saturday.
- Arrives at 3:30 pm weekday (or 12:30pm Saturday) to help Volunteer Coordinator in Volunteer Coordinator duties.
- Arrives at 3:30 to set up.
- Set up and disinfect table/chairs which will be available at church site.
- Collect and return resource tub which will be available at church site.
- Organize table prior to volunteers reporting.
- Train Volunteer Canvassers. Training guidelines will be sent prior to scheduled day by Volunteers In Service (VIS) and will be in each tub at church site.
- Bring list of Volunteers for church site – which will be emailed to Volunteer Coordinator from Volunteers In Service (VIS – Suzanne Reinink – sreinink@visgr.org) by noon on scheduled day.
- Be willing to field volunteer questions at church sites. Be willing to share cell number to canvassing volunteer on scheduled nights.
- Communicates clinic registration website. (Website will be supplied by noon on schedule day by VIS.)
- Puts together clipboards for next scheduled day. This will be in the tub.
- Distribute tablets (used to sign up individuals) and clipboards to each canvassing partner. Both will be in the tub.
- Disinfects tablets and clipboards at end of evening.
